

THREE SUNSETS 03DAYS / 02NIGHTS

MUYUNA

Day 01: Iquitos

You will easily find our staff waiting for you in Muyuna's counter in the Iquitos Airport. Immediately, the guide will take you to the harbor in nice buses while you look at the city of Iquitos.

Our speed boats will be waiting for you, ready to travel three hours upriver on the Amazon. Muyuna staff will be ready to welcome you with a typical and cold drink after arriving at the lodge.

After settling into your bungalow and having lunch, finally you will start your trip. A check list with the animals that have been previously seen will be provided.

Depending on the water level, you will use canoes or walk to the Pungal, this is an area that has several strangle figs, which is the favourite place of Hoatzin birds, these birds look like a prehistoric ones, because they have three hooks in their wings middle articulation, you will be surprised looking at them.

Ending the afternoon, you will see the sunset in the Sapote Lake.

By night, after having a refreshing shower, you will continue with the adventure looking for black and white caimans (jungle alligators) while you look at the stars of south hemisphere.

Day 02: Iquitos / Muyuna Lodge

Using canoes you will go to Juanachi Lake, which is difficult to access, because it is far and has many aquatic plants that appear at the entrance, this is the reason why you can appreciate the abundance of fauna and flora. Here you will walk or paddle, depending on the water level, looking the different types of birds like parrots, macaws, toucans, egrets, hawks, ducks, etc, also sloth and several monkeys like the night, squirrel and dusky titi ones.

After lunch, you will make a hike to the back of the lodge where you can observe the variety of flora that region has. In this hike you can try the water of the "Uncaria tomentosa" that has inside its vein it is said an ingredient, which can cure cancer and aids). Also you will be surprised at the giant ceiba trees.

You will have the opportunity to see the pygmy marmoset, the smallest monkey in the world, and if you are lucky, howler monkey, who's roar can be heard miles away! In this area on occasions, some felines can be seen.

After dinner, you will make a nocturnal hiking to the strangle tree, where live so many species of tarantulas (although their bad fame, they are not dangerous to humans).

Day 03:

Very early in the morning before breakfast, you will make a very efficient bird watching trip. This is the best hour to look for them because they begin their day feeding themselves in the trees. It will be very easy to see parrots, macaws, toucans, egrets, hawks, ducks, etc. The check list will help you to identify the different species you see.

Later, depending on the river level, you will be taken by motorboat to the Amazon River or some of the lakes to experiment the most magical moment of your trip: to see and listen to the pink Amazon River dolphins playing around your boat. Also our boats are equipped with a specialized headphones system to enjoy this unique experience.

In the way back to the lodge, you will see the biggest aquatic plant in the world, the famous Victoria Regia.

Then visit the Purura Lake where you will find different types of fish, like piranhas, silver hatched fish, etc.

After lunch, your wonderful experience in the jungle comes to an end; you will sail three hours back to Iquitos and be taken to the Airport.

Included:

- Airport transfers, but if you arrive between 11:00 pm and 05:00 am the transfer has a additional cost of U\$ 15.00 per taxi.
- Transfer from Iquitos to Muyuna Lodge by nice speed boats traveling three hours by the Amazon river.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner, are included during all days that passengers stay at Muyuna Lodge. Our delicious Peruvian dishes, prepared by Muyuna chefs. If you are vegetarian, please tell us in advance.

- Lodging in nice and private bungalows with their own bathroom and terrace with a hammock facing the river.
- Day and nocturnal excursions to look for animals.
- You can charge your camera battery in our generator. Ask the manager to do this.
- Expert bilingual naturalist guide from the area in charge of small groups.
- Visit small and remote local village to see how different life style the jungle people have.
- Tents and mattresses to make camping in the "Full Adventure" trip.
- A check list of animals that live close to the Muyuna area.
- Purified water during the whole trip.
- A friendly team eager to serve you in the lodge.
- First aid kit.

Not included:

- Flight tickets and airport taxes (although the flight tickets are not included in our prices, we can help you to organize the trip planning the schedule and buying the tickets).
- Travel or health insurance.
- Tips for the guide and members of the staff.
- Liquors and beverages.
